The Salmon feast is a three-day gathering for sn̓x̌aʔiwləm (to honour the sacredness of the river) and to express gratitude for chief ntytyix. The gathering includes traditional games, a canoe paddle and on the final day (Sunday) a Salmon Feast and ceremony.
