As part of our bursary program, we are pleased to offer three (3) \$1000 Syilx Siya bursaries. These awards are intended to recognize service, leadership, and community involvement.

Who is Eligible to Apply?

SYILX SIYA BURSARY ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- o You must be attached by ancestry, identity, and community to the Syilx Okanagan Nation
- o You must have graduated high school in the 2024-2025 school year.

Important Dates

- Syilx Siya Bursary Application Deadline: application packages must be received by 3 pm May
 15, 2025
- Award Announcement: early June 2025
- o **Payments:** June 2025

- Students must ensure all application requirements are met before applying (See Checklist)
- Students are responsible to ensure that all information is up-to-date and included in the submission package.
- o Only electronic submissions will be accepted. Include all attachments in one email. We will send you an email notification when your application has been received.

Syilx Siya Awards - \$1000 each (3 available)

The Syilx Siya Bursary is awarded to Syilx Okanagan high school graduates who have demonstrated a willingness to dream big for themselves, their Nation, their community, and/or their family. These awards are intended to recognize service, leadership, and community involvement.

Funding for the 2025 Awards Sponsored by:

EMB Awards for Syilx Students sponsored 2 awards

EMB: Formed in 2014, EMB Management Ltd. ("EMB") offers project development, project delivery, engineering, construction management and construction inspection services to utility and infrastructure clients across Western Canada. To help recognize high school graduates and recognize Syilx Okanagan Nation members in furthering their education, EMB introduced \$10,000 in total awards in 2022 as a component of our Building a Better Future Initiative. For the Syilx Siya Bursary, EMB has donated \$2000 towards two of the three Syilx Siya awards available.

FortisBC Education for Life sponsored 1 award

FortisBC: While building the Terasen Gas Southern Crossing Pipeline, Terasen Gas (now FortisBC) forged strong relationships with the member communities of the Okanagan Nation Alliance. In recognition, since 2009 Fortis BC established a Financial Award for Syilx Okanagan Nation members who are committed to building a better future for themselves and their community through post-secondary and vocational pursuits. This year FortisBC has added to that contribution by contributing toward one of the three Syilx Siya awards available.
