- You must be attached by ancestry, identity, and community to the Syilx Okanagan Nation
- Applicants must be enrolled in a post-secondary or vocational institution or display proof of acceptance, in full-time studies between: September 2025 August 2026 (unless otherwise noted in the specific award listing).

- Award Announcement: July 2025

# **Available Scholarships, Bursaries and Awards:**

#### 1. \$3000 in awards from FortisBC - Education for Life Awards

While building the Terasen Gas Southern Crossing Pipeline, Terasen Gas (now FortisBC) forged strong relationships with the member communities of the Okanagan Nation Alliance. In recognition, since 2009 Fortis BC established a Financial Award for Syilx Okanagan Nation members who are committed to building a better future for themselves and their community through post-secondary and vocational pursuits.

#### \$1500 Education for Life Awards (2 available)

The Education for Life Award is awarded to 2 Syilx Okanagan Nation members who have demonstrated their commitment to bettering their community, and who show aptitude for and commitment to their chosen career or area of study. Whether you're working towards a degree, master's, or trade certification, this opportunity is designed to provide financial support to help you achieve your educational goals. We recognize the diverse paths and ambitions of students, and we are committed to supporting their journeys towards success.

Must be pursuing a minimum 2-year program.

# 2. \$10,000 in awards from EMB for Syilx Students

Formed in 2014, EMB Management Ltd. ("EMB") offers project development, project delivery, engineering, construction management and construction inspection services to utility and infrastructure clients across Western Canada. To help support Syilx Okanagan Nation members in furthering their education, EMB introduced \$10,000 in awards (\$8000 in post secondary awards and \$2000 for high school graduates) in 2022 as a component of our Building a Better Future Initiative.

#### Their contribution will provide the following awards:

#### **\$3500 EMB Engineering Bursary**

With generous financial support, the EMB Engineering Bursary aims to empower aspiring engineers to pursue their academic goals with confidence. Whether you're fascinated by robotics, environmental sustainability, Biomedics, structures and design or any other engineering discipline, this bursary is open to students studying Engineering in the fall of 2025.

- Planning to attend an accredited post-secondary institution on a full-time basis pursuing a full-time (4 course minimum) engineering program.
- Open to high school students who are accepted into an engineering program and/or students continuing their pursuit in an undergrad or graduate program.

#### \$1500 EMB Surveying, Mapping, or Geomatics Bursary

This bursary is open to an <u>undergraduate</u> student studying surveying, mapping, or geomatics enrolled in full time studies in the fall of 2025.

#### \$1500 EMB Business Bursary

This bursary is open to <u>undergraduate</u> students enrolled in full time studies in the fall of 2024 who intend to study Business, Business Administration, Commerce, Management and/or related fields of study.

#### \$1500 EMB Walking My Learning Forward Award

The EMB Walking My Learning Forward Award, is dedicated to recognizing Syilx Okanagan Nation members who exhibit a strong dedication to community and display both aptitude and commitment to their chosen career or field of study.

- Applicants must be enrolled in an accredited educational institution.
- Applicants enrolled in a minimum two-year undergrad/trades program in the fall of 2025 are eligible
- Masters and PHD students are welcome to apply.
