Fisheries and Natural Resources Department (FNRD) Technician (2) – Term

The **Okanagan Nation Alliance (ONA)** is the Tribal Council for the Syilx Okanagan Nation. The ONA's mandate is to advance, assert, support, and preserve the Syilx Okanagan Nation Title and Rights. Further, the ONA is charged with providing members with a forum to discuss and form positions of common concern.

The ONA is currently seeking to employ two **Fisheries and Natural Resources Department (FNRD) Technicians** to support hydrometric monitoring and a variety of fisheries and natural resource initiatives. Hydrometric work will be the primary focus of this position; however, technicians may also assist with fisheries, habitat, hatchery, wildlife, GIS, LiDAR, and other field-based projects.

The successful applicants should be comfortable working in a fast-paced, dynamic, results-based environment and possess strong problem-solving, communication, time management, and safety management skills. This position will be based out of the Westbank office.

Key Duties and Responsibilities Include:

- Assist in hydrometric station installation and maintenance
- Assist in hydrometric data collection
- Assist in water sampling
- Assist the Field Lead and/or Hydrologist to meet the required outcomes of project assigned
- Research and study on water resources management, environmental flow needs and impacts of climate change on hydrology
- Provide field support to other Fisheries and Natural Resources Department initiatives as required

Qualifications and Experience

- Education or interest in the field of physical science is preferred.
- Must have good public relations and communication skills, computer literacy is essential.
- A valid driver's license is preferred.
- First Aid certification, Swift Water, and other applicable safety training is an asset.
- Applicants must be willing to work outdoors and be exposed to weather elements and work strictly to safety standards.
- Aboriginal Ancestry preferred.
